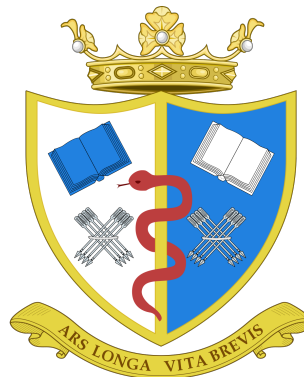




Super Mega Awesome 3a List
