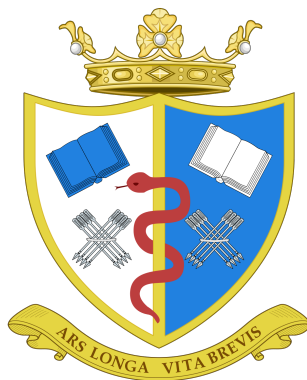




## Super Mega Awesome Finals List
